LOCAL BUS AND TRAIN SERVICES

Following the article in last month's *Pump*, new timetables have been issued for the 5, 325 and 377 service, there now being one each of the 5 and 325 services incorporated in the new 377 timetable. The 5 runs once daily on Monday to Friday and the 325 on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday allowing a morning in Chulmleigh. The 377 service will be run by Go Devon Bus, the 5 by Stagecoach and the 325 by Country Bus/Taw & Torridge. Timetables are printed overleaf and have also been posted on the *Pump* website via the News page.

Following campaigns by rail users, more trains are now stopping at Lapford while prices have been frozen whilst fares from other stations on the Tarka Line were increased at the annual inflation linked increases. Train times can be found on the various railway timetable websites. The campaign continues for ALL trains EVERY day to stop at Lapford..
