by the car park.

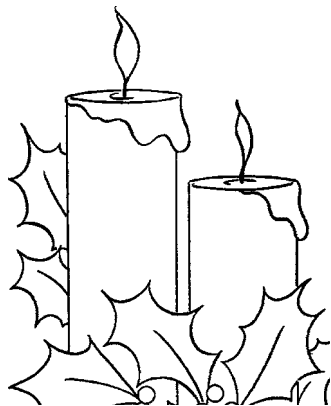
Our Library is still threatened, but the
